IDENTIFICATION:



-  [New Mexico Fishing License](#)
-  Government-issued identification or passport

FISHING GEAR:







-  1-2 Fly Rods – 5 wt, 6wt streamer rod or 4wt dry fly rod
-  Fly lines, leader and tippet materials
-  Flies (Available for purchase at the Rainbow lodge)
-  Nippers
-  Wading Socks

**All gear will be provided by the guide, however if you'd like to use your own this is what we suggest




HAT AND GLOVES:

-  Hats: winter hat, baseball style hat, wide brimmed sun protective hat
-  Gloves: sun gloves/warm gloves

TOP - WARM/LIGHT CLOTHING:







-  Polyester or natural fiber T-shirts, no cotton
-  Sweaters/sweatshirts
-  Long sleeved sun shirts (weather permitting or as a layer)
-  Sun shirts (weather permitting)
-  Tank tops (weather permitting)
-  Wool or poly top long sleeve (insulated underwear)

BOTTOM:







-  Jeans (camp only) or fleece pants
-  Water wicking leggings
-  Insulated underwear or other warm layer

OUTERWEAR:







**Weather in the fall is unpredictable, and may include snow

-  Waders are a must if you wish to wade on your own. (Water temp will be around 42F)
-  Boat shoes (chacos may be appropriate, but closed toed shoes should be brought in case of inclement weather)
-  Neck Tubes
-  Waterproof Rain Gear - jacket/pants
-  Wind proof layer
-  Down or Polyfill Coat



TOILETRIES:

-  Hand warmers
-  Medications and medicinal needs
-  Strong mosquito repellent w/DEET
-  Sunscreen
-  Baby wipes
-  Water bottle

ACCESSORIES:

-  Camera or Go-Pro
-  Lanyard
-  Lodge shoes (sandals or tennis shoes)
-  Polarized sunglasses and/or prescription eyewear (with leash) are essential
-  Waterproof bag with extra clothing
-  Device chargers

RECOMMENDED:

-  Snacks for in between meals
-  Cash for tipping the lodge staff and fishing guides
